## JOINT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, This prestigious accolade is bestowed upon William and Jacqueline Martin in recognition of their exemplary citizenship and service, with especial emphasis on the preservation and appreciation of the rich heritage and historical significance of Bergen County; and,
- WHEREAS, William and Jacqueline Martin's impressive record of service to history and historical preservation includes their efforts as the owners of the Circa 1895 Vernacular House in Westwood, which is a turn of the 20th century American Foursquare with four dormers, generous bay windows, and a large wraparound Colonial Revival porch; and,
- WHEREAS, In addition, William and Jacqueline Martin have distinguished themselves by the historically sympathetic expansion of the house's kitchen, which was designed by William and complements the architecture of the home; and,
- WHEREAS, William and Jacqueline Martin has inspired the support and participation of others and instilled a spirit of unity and optimism among all those who share their devotion to preserving history; and,
- WHEREAS, It is altogether proper and fitting for the New Jersey Legislature to acknowledge William and Jacqueline Martin's superb service to history and historical preservation, and to salute them as deserving recipients of an Historic Preservation Commendation Award; now, therefore,
  - Be It Resolved by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

That this Legislature hereby honors William and Jacqueline Martin, pays tribute to their many years of meritorious service to history and historical preservation, and extends to them this Legislature's best wishes; and,
